St Giles' Stained-Glass Windows

- Our stained-glass windows are part of the original design for the Church.
- Our architect advised us to have the windows properly inspected by an expert; this was carried out last year; the windows were generally in good condition, but some repairs were needed.
- As a result, work for necessary repairs to our windows began on Tuesday May 5th.
- During the work, some panels will be removed to be repaired off site; some repairs will be carried out on site.
- There will be external scaffolding to repair the East Window.
- The project will cost in the region of £39,000. Thankfully, nearly half of this will be covered by grant funding. We will also use some of the £50,000 left to the Parish by Fr Sandy, to cover other costs. Fr Sandy was keen that his legacy should be used for repairs to our Church building, and especially the stained-glass.
- **Any donations** towards the cost of this work would be much appreciated. Donations can be made using our card machine or cash or cheques can be placed in envelopes marked "Church Windows". Thanks to all those who have already made generous donations.
- The Church will remain open, and all Masses and other services will continue during the project.
- Work should be completed by the end of August.
