New Lectionaries

From Advent Sunday (Dec 1st, 2024) the Catholic Church in England and Wales will be using a different translation of the Bible Readings at Mass (The English Standard Version Instead of the Jerusalem Bible we currently use). Every Church will need to buy large copies of the new Lectionaries which contain all the readings we use at Mass.

The Lectionary is in 4 volumes:

Cost £150 per volume

We also need a new "Book of the Gospels" costing £235.

We will need copies of these new Lectionaries for St Giles' and St Thomas'.
