From Advent Sunday (Dec 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024) the Catholic Church in England and Wales will be using a different translation of the Bible Readings at Mass (The English Standard Version Instead of the Jerusalem Bible we currently use). Every Church needs to buy large copies of the new Lectionaries which contain all the readings we use at Mass. We have paid for the Lectionaries in advance to get a 15% discount. The newly published Lectionaries will arrive in October and be in use from December 1<sup>st</sup>.
