From Advent Sunday (Dec 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024) the Catholic Church in England and Wales will be using a different translation of the Bible Readings at Mass (The English Standard Version Instead of the Jerusalem Bible we currently use). The newly published Lectionaries will arrive in October and be in use from December 1<sup>st</sup>.
