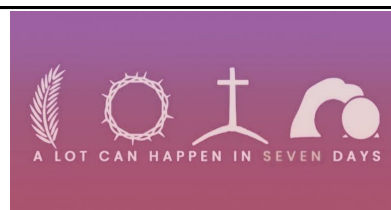

**Easter Sunday 17th April**

As they came to the empty tomb, Mary Magdalen and the disciples were at first dismayed; they couldn't honour Jesus' body. Sorrow turned to joy as they realised Jesus was alive and then met the Risen Lord. **Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!**



**2nd Sunday of Easter 23rd-24th April**

Today's Gospel show us that the Risen Lord carries the bodily marks of his Passion. His glorious Risen Body is really Jesus, fully human and fully divine. He comes with the message: "Peace be with you". We continue to need to hear these words.



**Palm Sunday 9th-10th April**

Palm Sunday Mass begins with a celebration of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, when the crowds proclaim that he is the long awaited Messiah, the Christ, the Son of God



The story moves quickly as we are drawn to contemplate Our Lord's journey to his suffering and death.

**3rd Sunday of Easter 30th April-1st May**

"I'm going fishing"; it looks a bit normal. He's returning to the life he had before he met Jesus and everything changed.

The Risen Jesus meets Peter and the others as they go about their business. He feeds them and restores them.



Holy Week is the final preparation for Easter. We focus on the Passion, the suffering and death of Jesus.

There's opportunity to come to Mass on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of Holy Week at St Giles' & St Thomas'.
