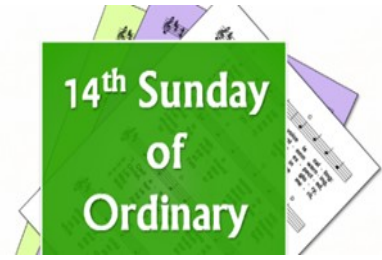

Thought for the Week.

"It is when I am weak that I am strong" St Paul says. This appears a strange thing to say but it is faith that allows him to think this way. He understands that God's grace is given to each of us, not according to what we deserve but according to need. It is probably true to say that it is when we are at our most vulnerable that we pray most earnestly. We are consciously or unconsciously aware of our need for God and his support to see us through the difficult times in our lives. The words he says to St Paul are the same as the words he says to us: "My grace is enough for you: my power is at its best in weakness." One is reminded of the parable 'Footprints' where a man, in discussion with God, looks back over his life and, seeing times where there are only one set of footprints asks God why in these times – which were the most difficult times in his life – there is only one set of prints. God's reply is "It was then that I carried you." How wonderful is our God that he loves each one of us so much that he comes to our aid whenever we need him and gives us the gift of his grace freely. All we have to do is open ourselves to receive it and, like St Paul, be content with our weaknesses and make them our special boast.
