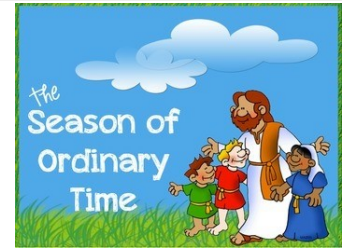

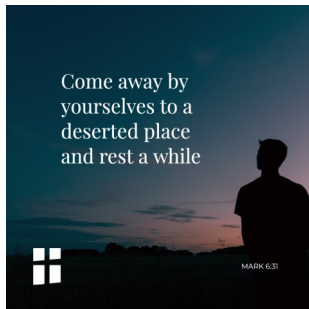

**Saturday Vigil Mass will definitely return to the former time of 5.00pm from Saturday 31st July.**

Whatever the changes in regulations and guidelines may be, this is necessary to allow for weddings on Saturdays.

Baptisms can be arranged with Fr Eric.

Numbers able to attend any services other than Baptisms (max 30), (Mass, Weddings or Funerals etc) are currently limited to the capacity of the Church with people masked & socially distanced: 60 at Cheadle; 35 at Tean.

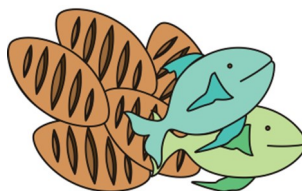
If it is safe to re-open St Giles' Church building with unrestricted access for personal prayer and general visiting, the earliest possible date for re-opening will be Monday 2nd August.

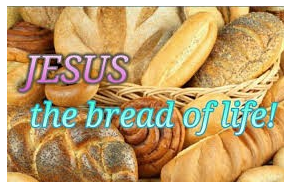
### Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 31st July- 1st August

But from 17th-21st Sundays in Ordinary Time, we are given Gospel Readings from St John's Gospel Chapter 6.

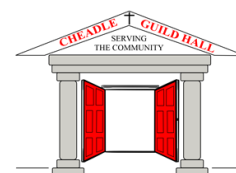
Last Sunday we heard about the 5,000 being fed.
