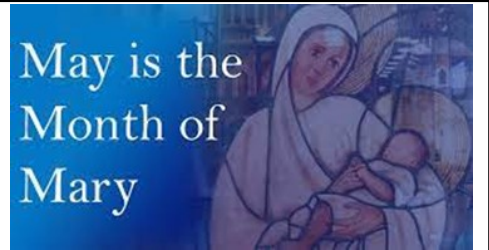

 Our Church buildings are open for Mass and Confessions. Church buildings can only be opened for Services at the moment.

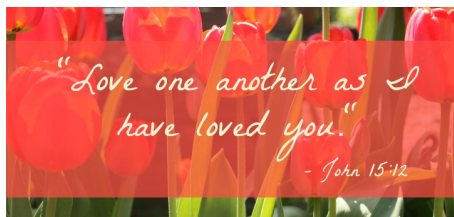

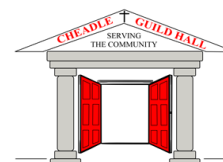
