**Work to replace the Guild Hall Roof begins on Monday 19th October; to be completed by Christmas.**

The Parish aided by our Diocesan Team of fundraisers has put a lot of work into seeking grants for the Guild Hall Roof. We are very grateful to All Churches Trust & Sir Harold Hood's Charitable Trust. We had hoped to receive more grants but in the present climate that is very unlikely.

**If this work is not done the Guild Hall would have to be permanently closed in the near future.**

**The work will be funded:**

- £20,000 - Guild Hall Cash Reserve built up over recent years
- £5,000 - Grant from St Giles' Church
- £2,700 - Grant from All Churches Trust Ltd
- £2,000 - Grant from Sir Harold Hood's Charitable Trust
- £70,000 - Loan from St Giles' Church

**The interest free loan from St Giles' Church to the Guild Hall will have to be repaid over a number of years.**
