To enable the replacement of the roof to go ahead, St Giles' Parish gave £5,000 & loaned £70,000 to the Guild Hall. We are delighted to report that owing to people's generosity & careful stewardship of resources, £20,000 has been repaid to the Parish. So the Guild Hall now owes the Parish £50,000.

To avoid disappointment, please book the Guild Hall early. Almost every Saturday is booked for the rest of this year.
