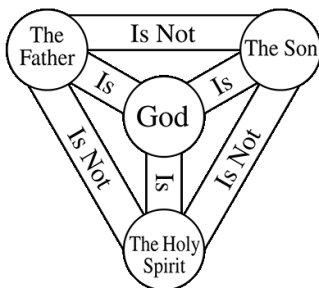

Thought for the Week.

Today we celebrate the birthday of the Church. The great plan of salvation is almost complete. The Word of God has become man for our sake; He has taught by word and example the way we are to follow; He has died to open up for us the way to the Father which we had lost; He has returned from death to prove to us that death is not the end of things but the beginning of a new life and now, after returning to the Father, Jesus sends the Spirit of Truth which He promised to us, to be with us until He returns at the end of time and the plan is finally complete. In the Creed we proclaim that the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son. By this we understand that only by returning to be with the Father could the Spirit come to us. It is the love between the Father and the Son which overflows in the Spirit and it is the Spirit who makes the love of the Father and the Son accessible and an active reality in our lives. Next week we celebrate the feast of the Blessed Trinity. This is at the centre of our faith. Today we celebrate the coming of the Spirit to the Church. Jesus breathes on His disciples as He gives them the Spirit – it is truly a part of Himself which He imparts to them and which He freely gives to all of those who believe. The Spirit helped the early Church to spread the Good News; He enabled those who heard the message to understand it and to assimilate it into their lives. He does the same for us today and enables us, like the early Church, to share the gifts He gives to us for the common good. Let us open our hearts to receive the gifts He offers.
